JOB TITLE: Fee for Service Behavior Specialist Consultant

LOCATION: 100 West Coulter Street, Philadelphia, Pa. 19144

ROLE: The BSC is responsible for providing evidence-based, clinically-sound behavioral planning while taking every necessary step to ensure that assigned clients are receiving proper treatment and that their behavioral, emotional, and treatment goals and needs are being correctly addressed. Collaboration with the family, school and other supports is a necessary important feature of this position.

STATUS: This position is a Fee for Service position. Agency benefits do not apply.

SALARY \$35.00 to \$38.00 per clinical contact hour for licensed BSC

\$33.00 to \$35.00 per clinical contact hour for unlicensed BSC.

Hourly rate is based on experience and credentials.

HOURS OF WORK: Assignments are based on pre-authorizations and are determined based on clients' needs. Morning, afternoon, and evening hours are available.

ESSENTIAL REQUIREMENTS

- A Master's degree from an accredited college or university in a clinical mental health discipline, such as Psychology, Clinical Social Work, Marriage and Family Therapy, Psychiatric Nursing or other related mental health degree. For a degree to count as a mental health degree, the degree must contain 12 credit hours in core behavior health coursework. No more than 3 of the 12 credit hours can be derived from a supervised clinical mental health practicum experience.
- BSC license or pending BSC license status required to work with Autistic Spectrum Disorder clients.
- An annual physical form verifying that the employee is "free from contagion".
- PA Child Abuse, PA Criminal, and FBI Clearances.
- Copy of official transcripts needed at time of interview to review all relevant coursework. Sealed transcripts at point job offer is made will be required.
- The ability and willingness to adjust work hours in accord with clinic hours and clients' schedules.
- The ability to meet all deadlines and participate in supervision and mandated training.

EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS

Two years' verified post-master's experience providing mental health treatment to children, and at least one year experience using behavior analysis/modification techniques. At least one year of

experience working with children and/or adolescents in a CASSP delivery system (i.e. mental health, special education, substance abuse, juvenile justice, etc.)
