JJC has a **Clinical Psychologist** opening in our Coulter Street office.

Job Summary

The Psychologist is an integral team member of the Behavioral Health (BH) department. This position is responsible for taking every necessary step to ensure that individuals in the BH program are receiving proper treatment in the least restrictive environment. The Psychologist is in the critical position of assessing whether the cognitive and behavioral needs of BH children and their families are being met. Therefore, a very important part of the Psychologist's role is to collaborate with team members to ensure proper treatment is rendered.

The Psychologist provides bio-psychosocial evaluations that may include referrals for various treatment alternatives and recommendations for behavioral interventions and level of care. The Psychologist may also be contacted to provide assessments for children not in the care of the BH program. Additionally, as collaboration and development are key elements of effectiveness, the Psychologist will also be called upon to provide supervision and training.

Qualifications

- Minimum of a master's degree from an accredited university in psychology specific discipline.
- Valid and current PA Psychologist license in good standing.
- Two years verified paid, clinical experience providing mental health treatment of a clinical nature.
- Current (no more than 60 days old at time of hiring) criminal history and child abuse clearances and FBI back ground clearances
- Current Professional Liability insurance
- The use of a currently inspected car, including the possession of current automobile insurance and driver's license, as needed.
- An annual physical form stating by a physician that the employee is "free from communicable" diseases
- Current CPR certification
